I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, hereby
proclaim, pursuant to Section 4 of the State Beach, Park,
Recreational, and Historical Facilities Bond Act of 1964,

That Chapter 1690, Statutes of 1963 of the Legislature
of the State of California, being the State Beach, Park,
Recreational, and Historical Facilities Bond Act of 1964,
was duly submitted to the people at the special election
consolidated with the General Election held on
November 3, 1964, and

That the votes cast thereat were counted, returned
and canvassed and declared in the same manner and subject
to the same rules as votes cast for state officers, and
said act received a majority of all of the votes cast for
and against it at the election, and that the act became
effective and shall be irrevocable until the principal
and interest of the liabilities therein created shall be
paid and discharged.
