AUTHORIZATION FOR TRANSFER OF MONEYS
SECTION 16310, GOVERNMENT CODE


WHEREAS, the State Controller has reported that the General Fund is exhausted and that there is money in the Special Deposit Fund (Motor Vehicle Department--Uncleared Collections Account) not required to meet any demand which has accrued or may accrue against it; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that, pursuant to Section 16310 of the Government Code, moneys may be transferred from the Special Deposit Fund (Motor Vehicle Department--Uncleared Collections Account) to the General Fund; and


WHEREAS, it is understood that any money so transferred under the authority of this authorization shall be returned to the respective funds as soon as there is sufficient money in the General Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor hereby orders that the Controller transfer not to exceed \$50 million, or so much thereof as may be needed from time to time during the balance of the month of January, from the Special Deposit Fund (Motor Vehicle Department--Uncleared Collections Account) to the General Fund under Section 16310 of the Government Code.
