EXECUTIVE ORDER B-9-75

WHEREAS, Consular Corps members serving in California assist the people of other countries in their dealings with California and aid the citizens of this state in their dealings abroad; and

WHEREAS, Consular Corps members keep their government officials informed of economic, cultural and political activities in California; and

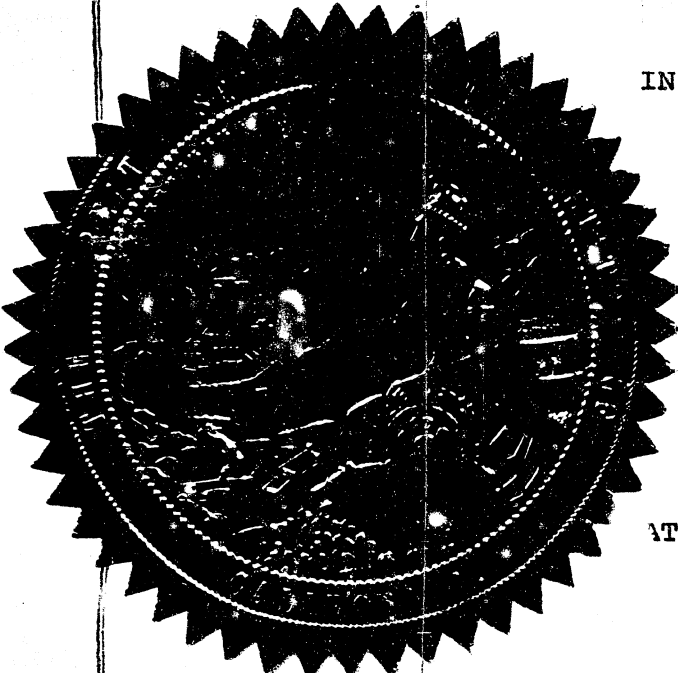
WHEREAS, Consular Corps members seek assistance and information from California officials from time to time; and

WHEREAS, it is helpful to California to maintain social, cultural and business relations with the people of other countries through their Consuls;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- I. Secretary of State March Fong Eu is designated Chief of Protocol for California; and
- II. She will represent the Governor and citizens of California at appropriate events held for or by members of the Consular Corps and other foreign officials; and
- III. She will serve as my liaison with the Consular Corps for the exchange of information about California government, economy and cultural life.
