SPECIAL ELECTION
PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, acting pursuant to the provisions of Section 23300 of the Elections Code, do hereby proclaim and order that the special election called by me in the First Congressional District of the State, to fill the vacancy in the office of Member of the House of Representatives from said district resulting from the death of Congressman Clem Miller, to be held on the 22nd day of January, 1963, be consolidated with a special election called for the same date by the Board of Directors of the Humboldt Bay Municipal Water District, to submit to the people of the district the question of whether the district shall execute a certain contract with the State of California pursuant to the Davis-Grunsky Act.
