WHEREAS, on the 21st day of July, 1960, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the County of Los Angeles, as a result of major and widespread fires creating conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property therein; and

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of July, 1960, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the Counties of Los Angeles and San Bernardino, as a result of major and widespread fires creating conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property therein; and

WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such States of Disaster are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies and political subdivisions within said counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said States of Disaster; and

I direct that this proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall, as soon hereafter as possible, be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California.


