



SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION


I, Edmund G. Brown, Governor of California do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 20th day of October, 1959, within the 56th Assembly District of the State, to fill the vacancy in the office of member of the Assembly from said District resulting from the death of Assemblyman Seth J. Johnson.

And I do hereby offer a reward of \$100 for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division XIV of the elections code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of \$10,000.
