SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 8th day of November, 1960, within the Seventy-ninth Assembly District of the State, comprising a portion of the County of San Diego, to fill the vacancy in the office of a member of the Assembly from said District resulting from the resignation of Assemblyman George G. Crawford.

And I do hereby offer a reward of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division XIV of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).
