P R O C L A M A T I O N
D E C L A R I N G T H E T E R M I N A T I O N

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of March, 1964, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the County of Los Angeles as a result of major and widespread fires creating imminent danger to the safety of persons and property and to the maintenance of essential services therein; and

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of April, 1964, the State of Disaster in the County of Los Angeles was proclaimed to exist as a result of excessively high winds and major and widespread fires and as a result of the heavy rains of March 22 - 24, 1964, immediately following the fires, causing extensive run-off of mud and silt, all creating imminent danger to the safety of persons and property and to the maintenance of essential services therein; and

WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such State of Disaster are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies and political subdivisions of that county;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said State of Disaster; and


