SPECIAL ORDER NO. 1

Special Order No. 1 Authorizing Release of Confidential Information, Section 7056, Revenue and Taxation Code.

Upon consideration of the request of Ramon Castro, Deputy City Attorney, Criminal Division, Office of the City Prosecutor, San Diego, California, for information obtained by the State Board of Equalization pertaining to the business affairs and operations of Strep's Warehouse, Inc., San Diego, California, to which said Board has issued Seller's Permits F-113937 and F-84595 pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Law, in conformity with the recommendation of the Board and good cause appearing, the Board is hereby authorized, pursuant to Section 7056 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, to furnish the information requested by said Ramon Castro so that employees of the Board when duly subpoenaed to testify in an action now pending against Strep's Warehouse, Inc., and its officers, Vincent Navarra and Esther Navarra, for violation of Section 17500 of the Business and Professions Code, may give evidence, both oral and documentary, concerning such matters and disclose any and all information obtained by them with respect to the activities of said corporation, its officers and activities of said corporation, its officers and employees, in the course of the performance of duties under the Sales and Use Tax Law.
