P R O C L A M A T I O N

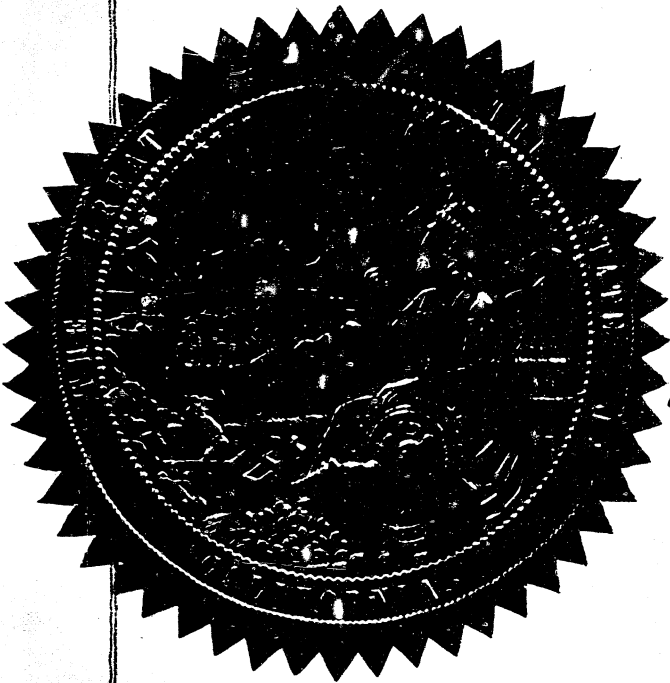
The increasing rate of traffic accidents caused by those driving under the influence of alcohol is a cause for ever-increasing concern in the enforcement of our laws.
