**P R O C L A M A T I O N**

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of California has been called in extraordinary session and has convened on February 3, 1964; and,

WHEREAS, On account of extraordinary occasions which have arisen and now exist, it is deemed desirable and necessary to submit additional subjects to the Legislature for consideration; now, therefore,

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, hereby amend and supplement my Proclamation dated January 30, 1964, by adding the following additional purposes thereto, and thereby permitting the Legislature to legislate upon the following subjects, in addition to the subject specified in the original Proclamation to wit:

Item No. 53. To consider and act upon legislation relative to restrictions on amending the Constitution.

Item No. 54. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the Placer County Water Agency.


Item No. 55. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the cancellation or refund of property taxes.


Item No. 56. To consider and act upon legislation relating to studies for additional toll crossings.
