EXECUTIVE ORDER B 4-75

I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, hereby issue this order to become effective immediately:


1. The Agriculture and Services Agency is designated as the State office to administer the Intergovernmental Personnel Act of 1970 (P.L. 91-648) for the State of California.
2. The Agriculture and Services Agency shall:
 - (a) Perform the necessary grant administration activities required under the Intergovernmental Personnel Act of 1970 including preparation of the required statewide plan.
 - (b) Evaluate the need for and, if appropriate, recommend programs to effectuate the non-grant provisions of the Intergovernmental Personnel Act of 1970.
3. The Intergovernmental Personnel Act Advisory Council is hereby established. It shall consist of not more than 5 members including a chairperson. Members of the Council and the chairperson shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
4. The Council shall carry out the following functions and responsibilities:
 - (a) To meet in public session to review and make recommendations on proposed programs and projects to be included in the California statewide plan under the Intergovernmental Personnel Act of 1970.
 - (b) To perform such other duties and fulfill such other responsibilities as may be assigned by the Governor or the Secretary of the Agriculture and Services Agency.
5. The Intergovernmental Personnel Act Advisory Council shall communicate to the Governor through the Secretary of the Agriculture and Services Agency.

6. Executive Order R-53-74 which extended the provisions of Executive Order R-30-71 creating the Advisory Coordinating Council on Public Personnel Management is hereby rescinded.
