PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has been called in extraordinary session and has convened on February 10, 1966; and

WHEREAS, on account of extraordinary occasions which have arisen and now exist, it is deemed desirable and necessary to submit additional subjects to the Legislature for consideration; now, therefore,

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power vested in me by law hereby amend and supplement my Proclamation dated February 9, 1966, by adding the following additional purposes thereto, and thereby permitting the Legislature to legislate upon the following subjects, in addition to the subjects specified in the original Proclamation, to wit:

Item No. 44. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the extraction and removal of geothermal fluids.

Item No. 45. To consider and act upon legislation relative to water districts.

Item No. 46. To consider and act upon legislation relative to scholarship programs for public school teachers.

Item No. 47. To consider and act upon legislation relative to compensation of the members of the California Women's Board of Terms and Parole.

Item No. 48. To consider and act upon legislation relative to California State Polytechnic College.

Item No. 49. To consider and act upon legislation relative to development centers for handicapped minors.

Item No. 50. To consider and act upon legislation relative to compensation of the members of the Narcotic Addict Evaluation Authority.

Item No. 51. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the licensing of home health agencies.
