WHEREAS, the United States Government, under the provisions of Public Law 85-606, has authorized the granting of matching funds for personnel and administrative expenses for the operation of civil defense organizations in the United States; and

WHEREAS, one of the conditions of such grants is that employees of such civil defense organizations must be employed under an approved merit system; and

WHEREAS, the California Disaster Office, which is the State civil defense organization, is part of the Governor's Office; and

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Article XXIV of the Constitution of the State of California excepts officers directly appointed by the Governor with or without the consent or confirmation of the Senate and the employees of the Governor's Office from the provisions of State civil service;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the authority granted under the provisions of Section 1518.1 of the Military and Veterans Code, do hereby direct that all officers and employees of the California Disaster Office, except the Director thereof, shall be employed under merit system standards which are in conformance with those stated in Office of Civil and Defense

Mobilization Manual M25-2; and that the Director of the California Disaster Office shall contract with the State Personnel Board, under the provisions of Section 11256 of the Government Code, for the administration of such merit system.

I FURTHER DIRECT that the provisions of this Executive Order shall become effective not later than January 1, 1961.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
