EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-17

Authorizing Disclosure of Sales Tax Information to  
California State Fair and Exposition.

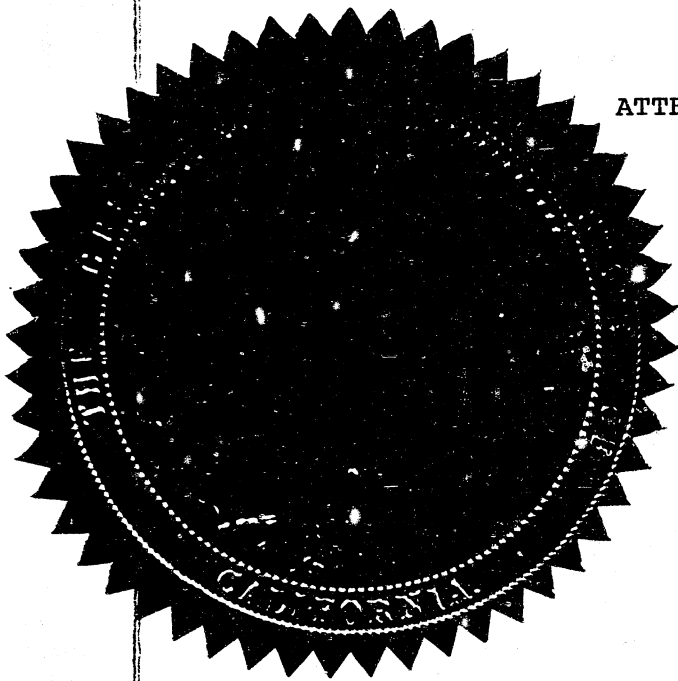
By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California and pursuant to Section 7056 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, upon your recommendation and good cause appearing, the Board of Equalization, its officers and employees, are authorized to permit the examination of retail sales and use tax returns and related records of sellers of tangible personal property who are concessionaires at the California State Fair and Exposition in Sacramento, by Mr. Harrison Cutler, Manager of the California State Fair and Exposition, or his authorized representatives, to the end that Mr. Cutler or his said representatives may verify the gross receipts from the operations of the concessionaires for the purpose of determining the accuracy of the payments made by them to the California State Fair and Exposition in accordance with their concession agreements.
