**AUTHORIZATION FOR TRANSFER OF MONEYS  
SECTION 16310, GOVERNMENT CODE**

WHEREAS, the State Controller has reported that cash in the General Fund will be exhausted on or about October 26, 1964, and that there is money in the Architecture Revolving Fund not required to meet any demand which has accrued or may accrue against it; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that, pursuant to Section 16310 of the Government Code, moneys may be transferred from the Architecture Revolving Fund to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that any money so transferred under the authority of this authorization shall be returned to the Architecture Revolving Fund as soon as there is sufficient money in the General Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor hereby orders that the Controller transfer not to exceed \$25 million, or so much thereof as may be needed from time to time during the balance of the month of October, from the Architecture Revolving Fund to the General Fund under Section 16310 of the Government Code.
