EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-18

Reorganization of the Department of Insurance

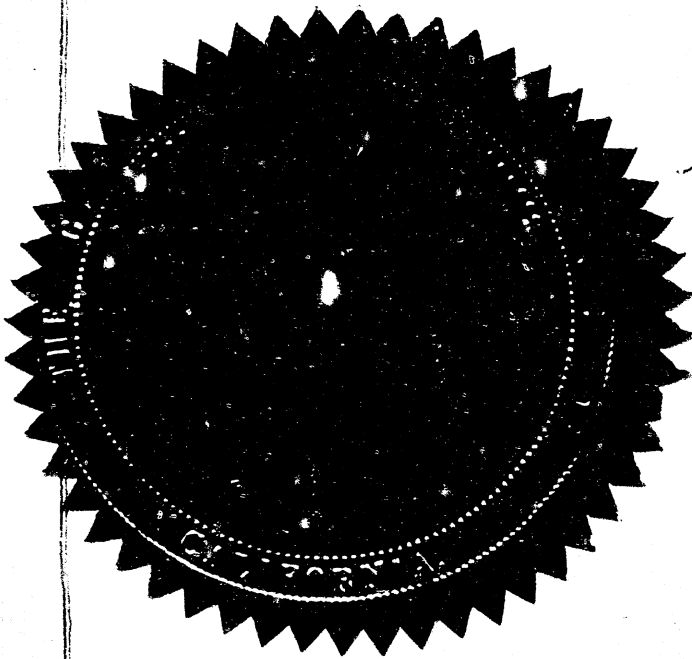
By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California and pursuant to Government Code Section 11152, I hereby approve the reorganization plan submitted by Insurance Commissioner Richard S. L. Roddis.

On September 1, 1966, the following organizational changes within the Insurance Department will be effective:

1. A new Division of Company Information and Analysis is created.
2. The rating function, which has been operating as a bureau, is elevated to divisional status and shall be known as the Rating Division.
3. The Legal Division is reorganized and shall consist of four bureaus in accordance with new assignments to be issued by the Commissioner.

The Insurance Commissioner is authorized to immediately implement this plan, as approved by the Administrator of the Business and Commerce Agency and the Director of Finance, through the issuance of formal regulations and departmental orders.
