The right of every man to choose freely his way of life and to pursue it in freedom is fundamental to the American way. Discrimination for reasons of race, religion or national origin is foreign to the principles on which this country is founded.

The fullest realization of our highest aspirations to achieve the brotherhood of man under the Fatherhood of God depends on building better human relations, religiously and racially, day by day; and each of us must bear a solemn obligation to fulfill this mission regardless of our religion, race, or national origin.

Therefore, I, Edmund G. Brown, Governor of California, in full accord with the National Conference of Christians and Jews, do hereby proclaim the week of February 15-22, 1959, as BROTHERHOOD WEEK in California, and I invite all our citizens to join with me in observing the tenets of this week.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed this 2nd day of February, A.D., One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Nine.
