SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 27th day of May, 1975, within the 37th Congressional District of the State to fill the vacancy in the office of Member of Congress from said District resulting from the death of Congressman Jerry L. Pettis.

AND I DO HEREBY offer a reward of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division 15 of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total number hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
