EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-19

Delegation of Authority to Implement Highway Safety Act of 1966.

WHEREAS, the Highway Safety Act of 1966 (Chapter 4 of Title 23, U. S. Code) urges the development of a highway safety program in each state and places in the governor of each state the responsibility for administering such program,

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California,

IT IS ORDERED that the Administrator of the Transportation Agency is hereby authorized to exercise, to the maximum extent permitted by federal and state law and regulations, all the powers and duties vested in me pursuant to the Highway Safety Act of 1966, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrator of the Transportation Agency shall keep the Governor's Traffic Safety Coordinating Council advised concerning the progress made in implementing the Highway Safety Act of 1966 in the State of California.

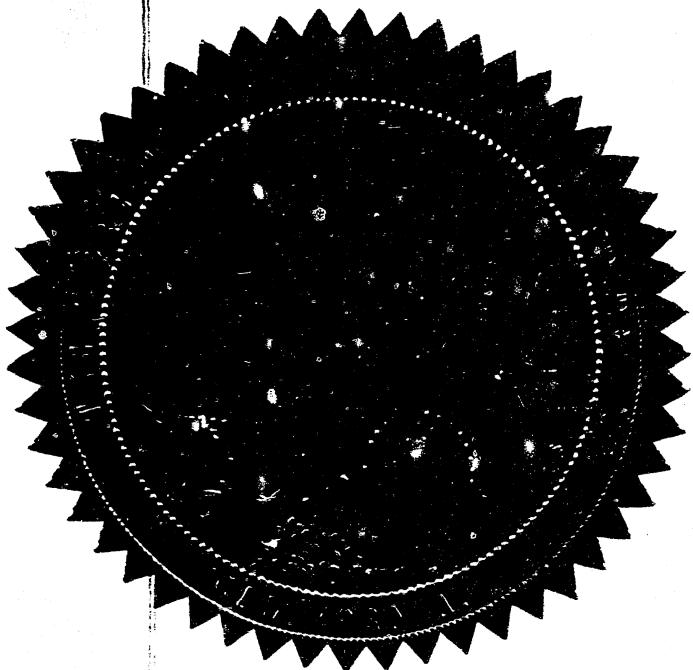
