PROCLAMATION  
DECLARING THE TERMINATION  
OF THE  
STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of January, 1965, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the City of Burbank as a result of destruction and damage of taxable property in that city due to flooding and hill slides caused by heavy rains; and


WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such State of Disaster are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal procedures, services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies of that city;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said State of Disaster; and

I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall, as soon hereafter as possible, be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
