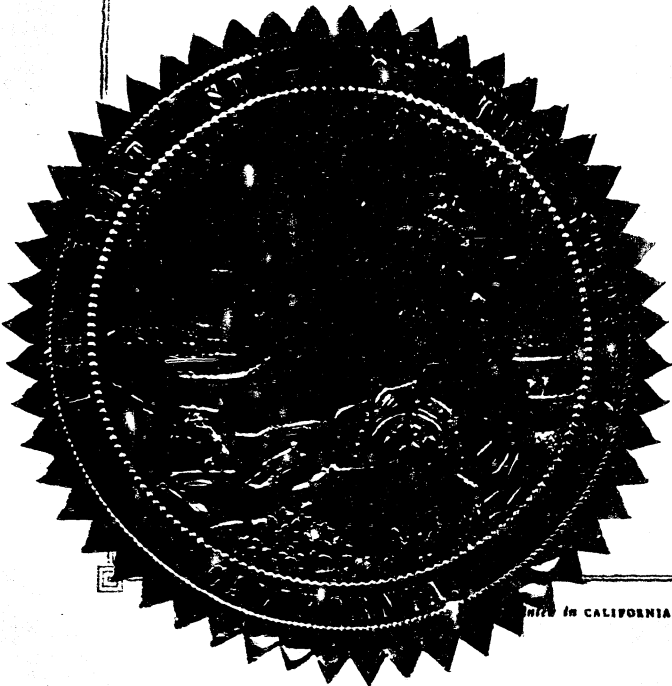
SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, pursuant to Section 2601 of the Elections Code and Chapter 26 of the Statutes of 1966 (First Extraordinary Session), hereby proclaim and order that a Special Election be held on the seventh day of June, 1966, and to be consolidated with the Direct Primary Election to be held on that date, to submit to the qualified voters of the State of California, the following measure proposed by the Legislature during its 1966 First Extraordinary Session:

Assembly Bill No. 100 (Chapter 26) of the 1966 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, to provide for the preparation, issuance and sale of state bonds to create a fund to provide aid to school districts of the state; defining the powers and duties of state officers in respect to the administration of the provisions hereof; providing ways and means for the payment of the interest of such bonds as such interest falls due, and also for the payment and discharge of the principal of such bonds as such principal matures; appropriating money for the purpose of carrying out this chapter; and providing for the submission of the measure to the people at a special election to be consolidated with the 1966 direct primary election.

And I do hereby offer a reward of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division 15 of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
