**AUTHORIZATION FOR TRANSFER OF MONEYS**  
**SECTION 16310, GOVERNMENT CODE**

WHEREAS, the State Controller has reported that cash in the General Fund will be exhausted on or about December 18, 1964, and that there is money in the Architecture Revolving Fund, Motor Vehicle Fuel Fund, Motor Vehicle Fund, School Land Fund, Real Estate Education and Research Fund, Transportation Rate Fund, California Water Fund, Central Valley Water Project Construction Fund, and Highway Fund not required to meet any demands which have accrued or may accrue against such funds; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that, pursuant to Section 16310 of the Government Code, moneys may be transferred from such funds to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that any money so transferred under the authority of this authorization shall be returned to the respective funds as soon as there is sufficient money in the General Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Governor hereby orders that the Controller transfer not to exceed \$110 million, or so much thereof as may be needed from time to time during the balance of the month of December, from said funds to the General Fund under Section 16310 of the Government Code.
