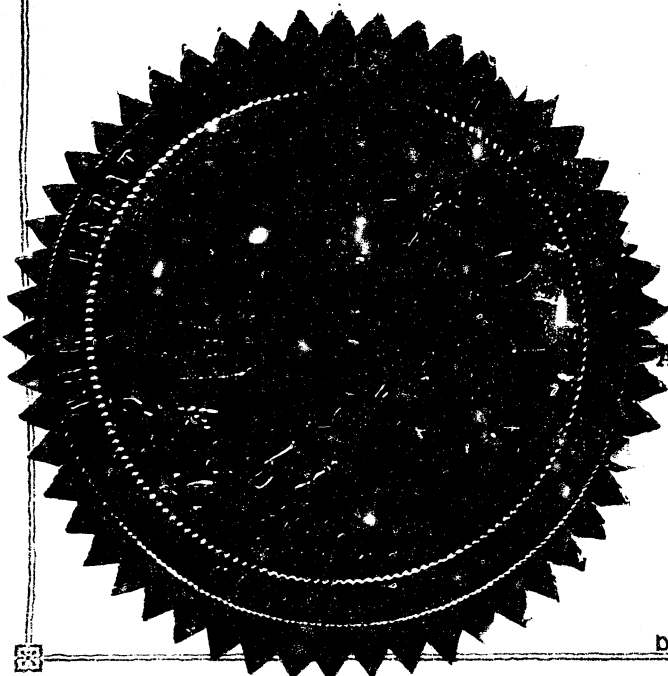

SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 1st day of April, 1975, within the 29th Senatorial District of the State (as described in Section 30100 of the Elections Code) to fill the vacancy in the office of Member of Senate from said District resulting from the resignation of Senator Mervyn M. Dymally.

AND I DO HEREBY offer a reward of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division 15 of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total number hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
