EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-5

Authorization of Disclosure of Information from Sales Tax Files
to Department of Public Works

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California, and pursuant to Section 7056 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, permission is hereby given the Board of Equalization to permit the examination of returns relative to sales or use taxes by representatives of the Division of Highways of the State of California, designated by the Director of Public Works or the State Highway Engineer.

Permission is further given to supply to such authorized representatives information taken from such records and requested by them for use in connection with studies of the economic effect of the location and re-location of state highways and the construction of freeways on the business transactions of affected retailers.
