EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. B 5-75

WHEREAS, the Legislature has enacted the Agricultural Labor Relations Act of 1975; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Act an Agricultural Labor Relations Board is created effective August 28, 1975; and

WHEREAS, in order that said Board may commence to function on August 28, 1975, with a minimum of delay, it is desirable that a draft implementation plan be developed prior to August 28, 1975, for use by the Board, at its option;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

A Temporary Office of Agricultural Labor Relations is created in the Governor's Office; and

Personnel assigned to said Office shall be under the direction of the Chief, Temporary Office of Agricultural Labor Relations, who shall provide staff to the consultants retained by the Governor's Office to draft a plan for implementation of the Agricultural Labor Relations Act of 1975; and

Said Office will cease to exist midnight August 27, 1975.
