

# Electoral Administration

State of California - Central Department

December, October 1st, 1871.

Notice is hereby given that a General Election will be held throughout the State, on Tuesday, the 1st day of November, A. D. 1872, when the following officers are to be elected:

Seven Representatives to the Congress of the United States, to be elected in the following manner:

The Representatives in the first Congress shall be elected, comprising the City and County of San Francisco.

The Representatives in the second Congress shall be elected, comprising the Counties of Contra Costa, Alameda, San Joaquin, Colusa, Sutter, Nevada, and Humboldt.

Fourthly, Sacramento, Placer, Nevada, El Dorado, and Butte, comprising the Counties of Nevada, Sierra, Yuba, Siskiyou, Humboldt, Trinity, Shasta, Steikey, and Butte, Plumas, Yuba, Siskiyou, Butte, and Nevada, comprising the Counties of Nevada, Sierra, Yuba, Siskiyou, Humboldt, Trinity, Shasta, Steikey, and Butte.

The Representatives in the third Congress shall be elected, comprising the Counties of Nevada, Sierra, Yuba, Siskiyou, Humboldt, Trinity, Shasta, Steikey, and Butte.

The Representatives in the fourth Congress shall be elected, comprising the Counties of Nevada, Sierra, Yuba, Siskiyou, Humboldt, Trinity, Shasta, Steikey, and Butte.

The Representatives in the fifth Congress shall be elected, comprising the Counties of San Diego, Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo, Fresno, Kern, Mendocino, Monterey, Orange, Santa Cruz, and San Francisco.
