EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-12

Coordination, preparation and submission of state comments and recommendations on expiring Federal Power Commission licenses.

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. The Administrator of the Resources Agency shall be the person to coordinate the preparation and submission of the state's comments and recommendations and the taking of other appropriate actions on behalf of the Governor regarding the review of expiring licenses for hydroelectric projects licensed by the Federal Power Commission. The Administrator of the Resources Agency shall provide the official state comments and position on my behalf to the Federal Power Commission and other interested agencies as may be appropriate.
2. All units of state government having an interest in the recapture or relicensing of projects licensed by the Federal Power Commission shall coordinate their comments and recommendations as directed by the Administrator of the Resources Agency.
3. The Administrator of the Resources Agency shall establish appropriate procedures to be followed for adequate solicitation and coordination of the views of state governmental units and the timely submission of state comments and recommendations to the Federal Power Commission. The Administrator shall make these procedures available to all interested state governmental units.
