The week of January 12-18 is being observed as National Civil Service Week throughout the country, and January 16 will mark the 76th anniversary of the Federal Civil Service Act.

There are 233,000 Federal civil servants in California alone, men and women whose efficiency and dedication to their work deserves continuing recognition from a grateful government and public.

State and local governments, as well as the Federal government, have come to rely upon the civil service system to provide employees on a merit basis, and civil service is now an integral part of our governmental system at every level.

At the request of the American Federation of Government Employees, which has traditionally sponsored observances of the anniversary of the Civil Service Act, I therefore proclaim the week of January 12-18, 1959 to be CIVIL SERVICE WEEK in California.
