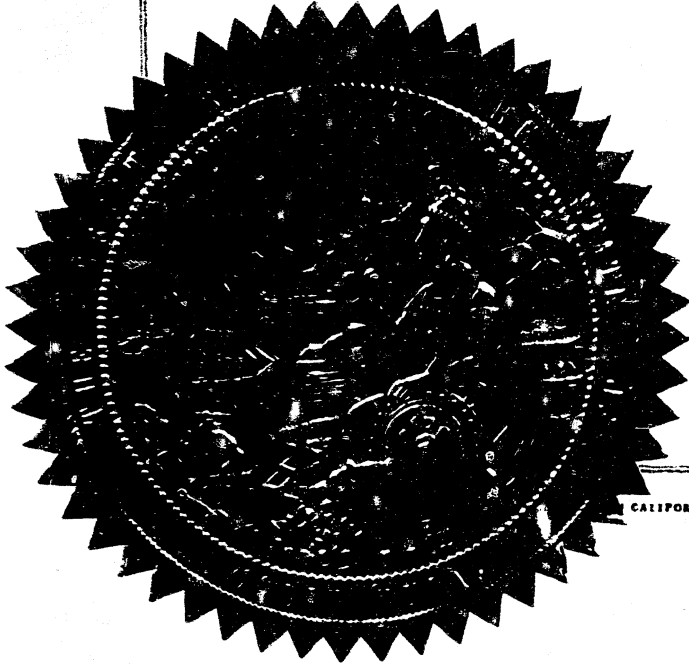
All of these activities have proved to be of tremendous benefit to all the citizens of our State and Nation by strengthening our moral fiber and by assuring all of us of a better future.
