WHEREAS, on the 16th day of January, 1961, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the County of Ventura, as a result of high tides and waves caused by storms at sea creating conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property therein; and

WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such a State of Disaster are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies and political subdivisions within said county;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said State of Disaster; and

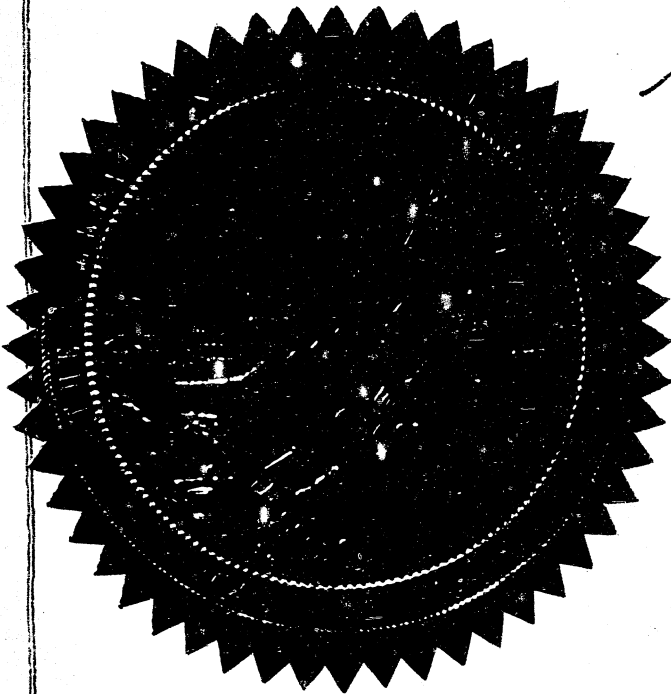
I direct that this proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall, as soon hereafter as possible, be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California.
