EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-9

Authorization to disclose information from sales tax files to managers or other authorized representatives of District Agricultural Associations.

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California, and pursuant to Section 7056 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, upon recommendation of the Board of Equalization and good cause appearing, the Board of Equalization, its officers and employees, are hereby authorized to permit the examination of retail sales and use tax returns and related records of sellers of tangible personal property who are concessionaires at District Agricultural Association fairs by the managers or other authorized representatives of these fairs to the end that the managers or other authorized representatives may verify the gross receipts from the operations of the concessionaires for the purpose of determining the accuracy of the payments made by them to the fair association in accordance with their concession agreements.
