SPECIAL ORDER NO. 4

WHEREAS, THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON PROBLEMS OF INSANITY RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENDERS -- PROCEDURAL was created by Executive Order dated May 4, 1960, pursuant to Section 6027 et seq. of the Penal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has made great progress in the study of problems of insanity but by reason of the scope of its mission will be unable to complete such studies within the period heretofore established for its final report, to wit, June 30, 1962, and

WHEREAS, in addition to its original mission I have since asked the Commission to study and review the present laws and practices pertaining to sexual psychopathy, making it necessary that further time be provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Special Commission on Problems of Insanity Relating to Criminal Offenders -- Procedural, is hereby continued and instructed to present its final report and recommendations not later than June 30, 1963 in the manner prescribed by Section 6028.3 of the Penal Code.
