**PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of California has been called in extraordinary session and has convened on February 3, 1964; and,

WHEREAS, On account of extraordinary occasions which have arisen and now exist, it is deemed desirable and necessary to submit additional subjects to the Legislature for consideration; now, therefore,

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, hereby amend and supplement my Proclamation dated January 30, 1964, by adding the following additional purposes thereto, and thereby permitting the Legislature to legislate upon the following subjects, in addition to the subject specified in the original Proclamation to wit:

Item No. 43. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the granting of tax relief in cases of disaster.

Item No. 44. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the Solano County Flood Control and Water Conservation District.

Item No. 45. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the San Benito County Water Conservation and Flood Control District.

Item No. 46. To consider and act upon legislation relative to districts formed under the California Water District Law.


Item No. 47. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the creation of zones within districts formed under the Water Conservation Act of 1931.

Item No. 48. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the Atherton Channel Drainage District.

Item No. 49. To consider and act upon legislation relative to the change of boundaries of districts formed under the Municipal Water District Law of 1911 and the Metropolitan Water District Act.

Item No. 50. To consider and act upon legislation relative to legislation to be considered at budget sessions of the legislature.


