WHEREAS, The President of the United States has asked me to serve as honorary chairman of the Payroll Savings Bonds Campaign in the State of California; and

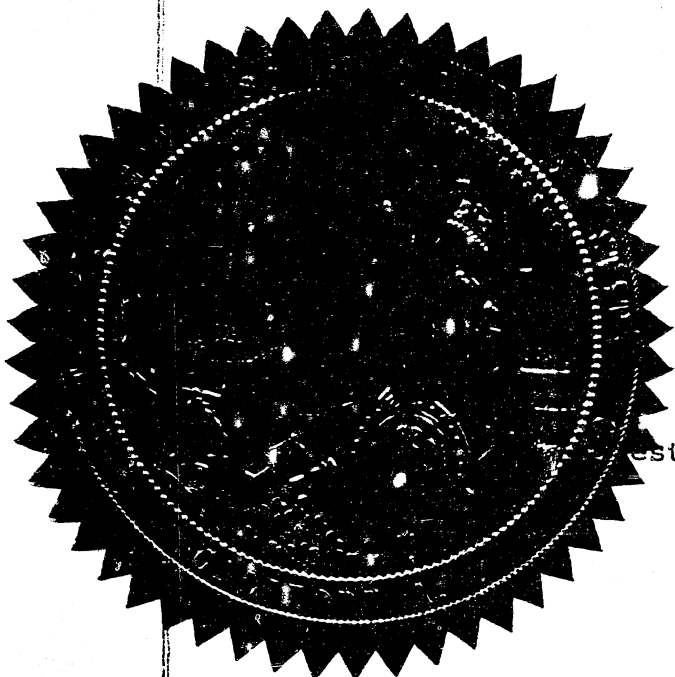
