EXECUTIVE ORDER 66-13

Authorization for the Board of Equalization to make information from sales tax records available to authorized representatives of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of California, and pursuant to Section 7056 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, and in furtherance of a reciprocal arrangement existing between the federal government and the State of California, upon recommendation of the State Board of Equalization and good cause appearing therefor, I hereby authorize Peter Sexton, Senior Resident Agent in Charge, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Sacramento, and any other duly authorized representatives of the Federal Bureau of Investigation to be permitted by the State Board of Equalization to examine returns made under the California Sales and Use Tax Law.

This authorization supersedes all previous authorizations heretofore made under Section 7056 with respect to the personnel of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
