D I R E C T I O N

To the State Treasurer under provisions of The State College Revenue Bond Act of 1947 (Stat. 1947, c. 1153, as amended).

To The Honorable Bert A. Betts, State Treasurer:

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the California State Colleges, on April 14, 1966, adopted a resolution authorizing the issuance of the San Diego Campus Student Union Revenue Bond Anticipation Notes of said Trustees in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2,940,000, and said resolution was approved by the State Board of Control of the State of California at a meeting duly and regularly held on May 3, 1966;

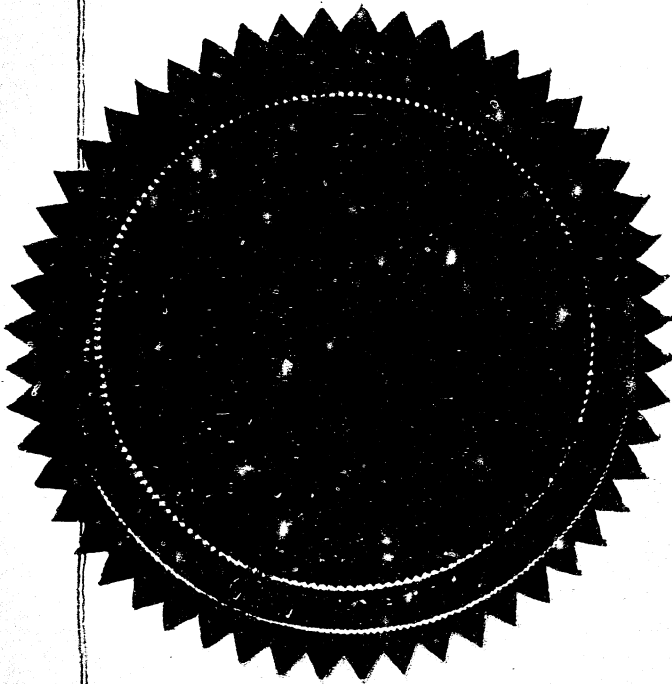
WHEREAS, said resolution of the Trustees of the California State Colleges requested that the State Treasurer be directed to sell said Notes at private sale, at such prices and interest rate or rates and in such parcels and numbers as may be negotiated by or on behalf of the Trustees, with your concurrence, and in such amounts and at such times as shall be designated, pursuant to the authority delegated by said resolution, by the Chancellor of the California State Colleges; and

WHEREAS, \$600,000 principal amount of said Notes have heretofore been sold, and the Chancellor of the California State Colleges has designated \$800,000 as the amount of, and no later than October 18, 1966 as the date for, the second sale of said Notes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, hereby direct that you, as State Treasurer, sell said Notes at private sale, at such prices and interest rate or rates and in such parcels and numbers as may be negotiated, and pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in said resolution of the Trustees of the California State Colleges. Said Notes to be so sold shall not exceed \$800,000 in aggregate principal amount, and shall be dated the date of delivery thereof and payment therefor. Sales shall take place at the office of the Treasurer of the State of California, State Capitol, Sacramento, California, at such time or times as you may determine, but not later than October 18, 1966.
