PROCLAMATION
OF A
STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of California empower the Governor to proclaim a State of Disaster in an area or region of this State affected or likely to be affected by certain conditions of extreme peril to persons and property within the State, which proclamation shall be in writing and shall take effect immediately upon its issuance; and

WHEREAS, it is further provided by Section 2.8 of Article XIII of the Constitution, as adopted by the people of California at the general election held on November 3, 1964, with the passage of Proposition No. 12, that the Legislature shall have the power to provide for, or authorize local taxing agencies to provide for, any appropriate relief from ad valorem taxation where (a) after the lien date for a given tax year taxable property is damaged or destroyed by fire, flood, earthquake or other act of God, and (b) the damaged or destroyed property is located in an area or region which was subsequently proclaimed by the Governor to be in a State of Disaster; and

WHEREAS, I, as Governor of the State of California, have found and do hereby find:

1. That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within this State did arise and exist in the City of Burbank, State of California, as a result of flooding and hill slides caused by heavy rains beginning November 9, 1964; and
2. That the Governor has been requested to proclaim a State of Disaster therein by the President of the City Council of the City of Burbank; and
3. That local authority in directly affected areas was inadequate to cope with the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril

by reason of their magnitude; and

4. That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a State of Disaster.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the existence of a State of Disaster in the City of Burbank, State of California; and

I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately, effective November 9, 1964, and that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California; and that widespread publicity and notice be given to this proclamation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
