WHEREAS On November 13 we observe California Citizenship Day--the anniversary of the ratification of the first Constitution of the State of California; and

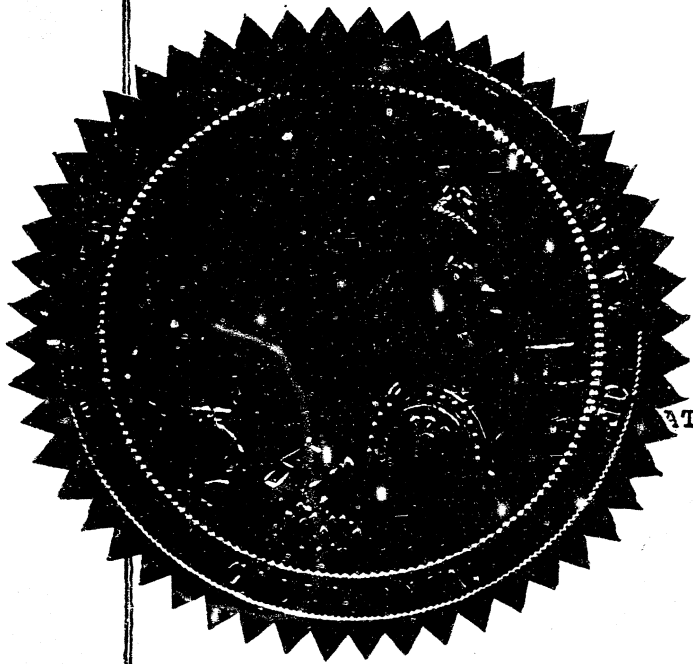
WHEREAS A primary concern of all Californians, now as in the past, is the respect for, maintenance of, and perpetuation of law and order in our society; and
