SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 8th day of December, 1959, within the Forty-first Assembly District of the State, consisting of a portion of the County of Los Angeles, to fill the vacancy in the office of State Assemblyman from said District resulting from the resignation of Assemblyman Allen Miller.

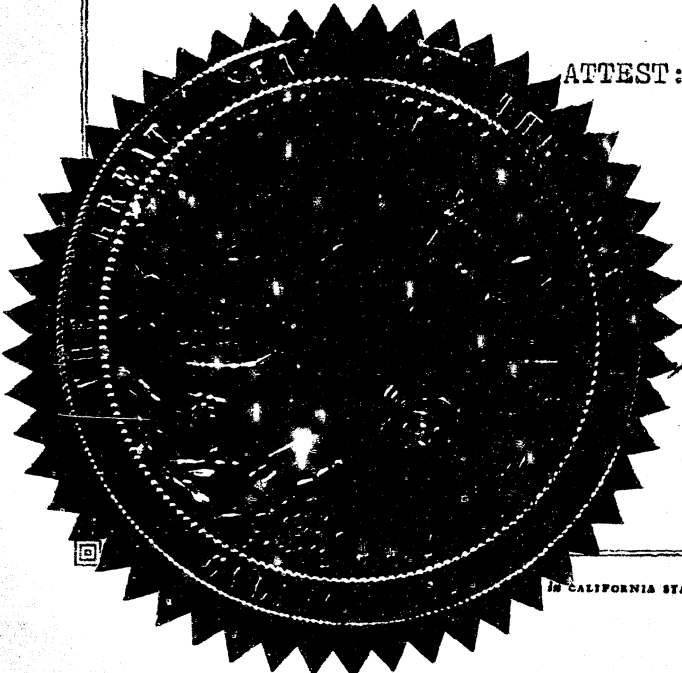
