PROCLAMATION
DECLARING THE TERMINATION
OF THE
STATE OF EXTREME EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of August, 1965, a State of Extreme Emergency was proclaimed to exist in the County of Los Angeles as a result of a riot within that county, causing conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within this state; and

WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such State of Extreme Emergency are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies and political subdivisions of that county;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said State of Extreme Emergency; and

I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall, as soon hereafter as possible, be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California.

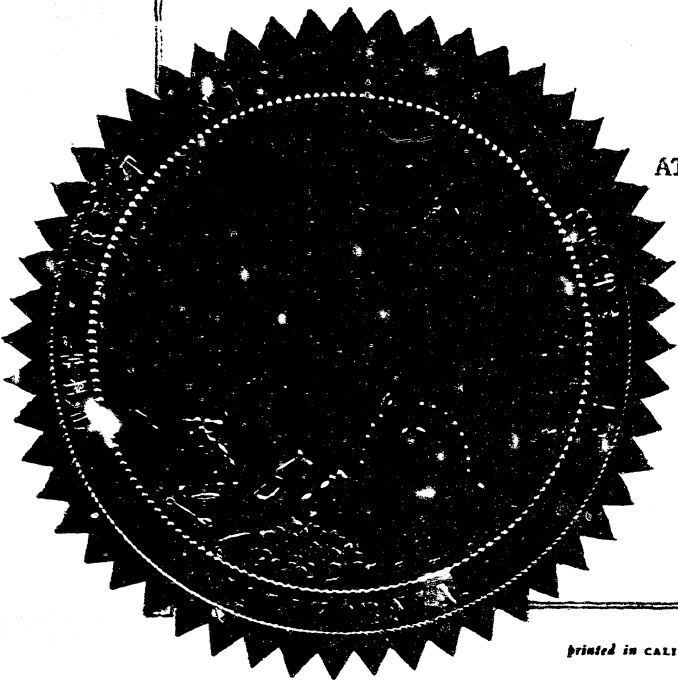
