PROCLAMATION  
DECLARING THE TERMINATION  
OF THE  
STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of February, 1963, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the Counties of Alpine, Nevada, Placer, Plumas and Sierra as a result of the abnormally heavy and continuous rainfall which started on or about January 30, 1963, and the resultant unprecedented run-off, causing extensive rain-storm and flood damage and threat of further danger to the lives, health and well-being of persons, the safety of public and private property, and the maintenance of essential services; and

WHEREAS, a State of Disaster was subsequently proclaimed to exist in the Counties of Amador, Colusa, El Dorado, Glenn, Lake, Lassen, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Siskiyou, Tehama, Tulare and Yolo on February 26, 1963, and in the Counties of Mono and Trinity on March 29, 1963, and in the County of Yuba on April 22, 1963, all as a result of the same storm; and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of February, 1963, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the County of Orange, as a result of abnormally high tides and heavy surf of the Pacific Ocean, which started on or about February 5, 1963, creating imminent danger to the lives, health and well-being of persons, the safety of public and private property, and the maintenance of essential services; and


WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such State of Disaster are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies and political subdivisions of those counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said State of Disaster; and


I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall, as soon hereafter as possible, be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of California to be affixed.
