SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, pursuant to Section 2601 of the Elections Code, Chapter 3 of the Statutes of 1962 (First Extraordinary Session), Chapter 21 of the Statutes of 1962 (First Extraordinary Session), and Chapter 25 of the Statutes of 1962 (First Extraordinary Session), hereby proclaim and order that a Special Election be held on the fifth day of June, 1962, to submit to the qualified voters of the State of California, the following measures proposed by the Legislature during its 1961 Regular Session and its 1962 First Extraordinary Session:

Senate Constitutional Amendment No. 10 of the 1961 Regular Session of the Legislature (Resolution Chapter 251), relating to state bonds for the construction of low rent housing for the elderly, and

Senate Bill No. 2 (Chapter 24) of the 1962 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, relating to state bonds for state park and relating purposes, and

Senate Bill No. 31 (Chapter 23) of the 1962 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, relating to state bonds to finance the construction of state buildings, including junior colleges, and

Senate Bill No. 40 (Chapter 21) of the 1962 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, relating to state bonds for school building construction, and

Assembly Bill No. 25 (Chapter 25) of the 1962 First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature, relating to an extension of daylight savings time, and

Assembly Bill No. 51 (Chapter 22) of the 1962  
First Extraordinary Session of the Legislature,  
relating to state bonds for assisting California  
veterans to acquire farms and homes.

I do hereby offer a reward of one hundred dollars  
(\$100) for the arrest and conviction of any person who  
violates any of the provisions of Division 15 of the  
Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total  
amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the  
sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
