The Holy Week message tells Christians of a peace beyond present conflict and arms them to endure with grace and fortitude the trials of the present.

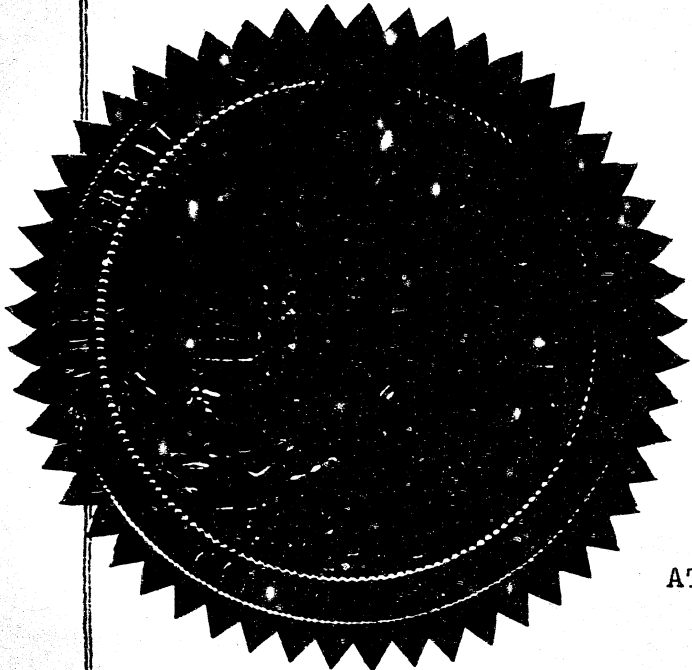
