PROCLAMATION  
DECLARING THE TERMINATION  
of the  
STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of September, 1965, a State of Disaster was proclaimed to exist in the Counties of Marin, Napa, Placer, Solano and Sonoma as a result of major and widespread fires and the excessively high winds in those areas, causing conditions of extreme peril to persons and property in those counties; and

WHEREAS, the conditions warranting and necessitating the proclamation of such State of Disaster are now deemed not to be beyond the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the public agencies and political subdivisions of those counties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby proclaim the termination of said State of Disaster; and

I DIRECT that this proclamation shall take effect immediately and shall, as soon hereafter as possible, be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of California.

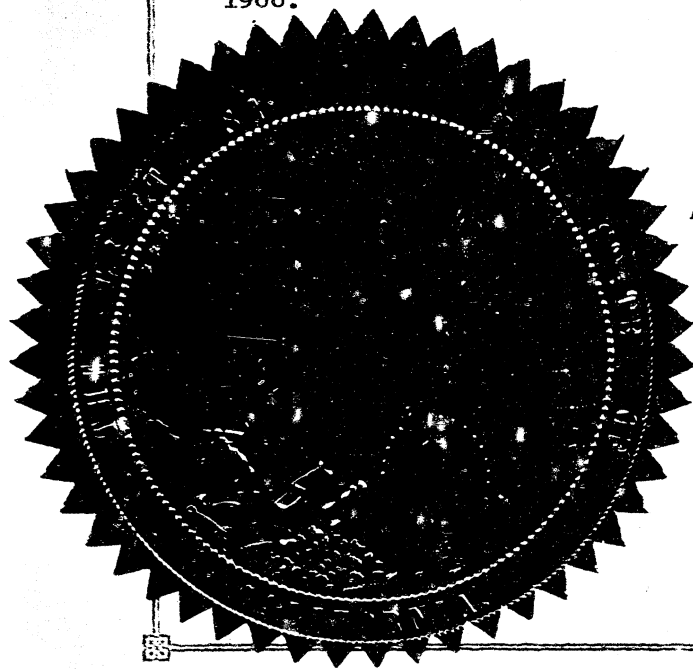
