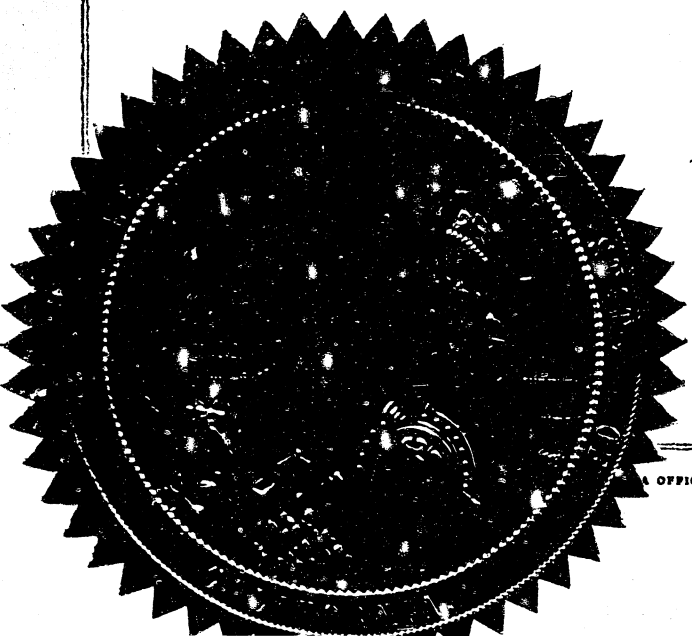

SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby pro-
claim and order in accordance with the provisions of Section 2601
of the California Elections Code that a special election shall be
held on the fifth day of July, 1966, within the Fourteenth
Congressional District of the State, (as described by Chapter
1234 of the Statutes of 1961), to fill the vacancy in the office
of Member of the House of Representatives from said district
resulting from the death of Congressman ^{John} James F. Baldwin. Under
the provisions of Section 7201 of the California Elections Code,
a primary election shall be held on June 7, 1966, in conjunction
with the special election scheduled for the fifth day of July,
1966.

AND I DO HEREBY offer a reward of one hundred dollars
(\$100) for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates
any of the provisions of Division 15 of the California Elections
Code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter
expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars
(\$10,000).
