A PROCLAMATION OF AN ALTERNATIVE
TEMPORARY SEAT OF STATE GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, section 38 of Article IV of the California Constitution, as approved and ratified at the general election held on November 4, 1958, and Chapter 61, Statutes of the 1958 First Extraordinary Session, are now in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, section 1 of said Chapter 61 provides that the Governor shall designate by written proclamation an alternative temporary seat of government for use in the event of war or enemy-caused disaster, or the imminence thereof; and

WHEREAS, under the aforesaid provisions of the Constitution and statutes of California, the City of Chico has been designated as the alternative temporary seat of government; and

WHEREAS, conditions now existing warrant a change in the designation of the alternative temporary seat of government;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State and particularly by section 1 of said Chapter 61, do hereby proclaim that the City of Folsom shall be the alternative

temporary seat of government for use in the event of war or enemy-caused disaster or the imminence thereof. I further direct that this proclamation shall take effect immediately, and that as soon hereafter as possible this proclamation be filed with the Secretary of State.

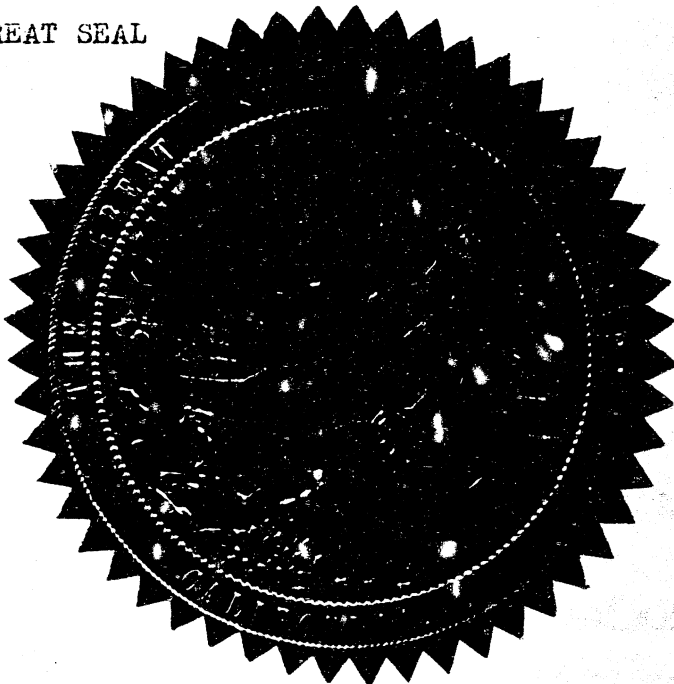
