FROM: EDMUND G. BROWN, GOVERNOR

Pursuant to Chapter 1.5 of Division 1 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, and in order to provide for the continued operation of the State plans for Aid to the Aged, the Needy Blind, Needy Children and Needy Disabled under the provisions of the Welfare and Institutions Code, I do hereby find as facts:

That assistance to this State for the above-mentioned Public Assistance programs is provided for by the Federal Social Security Act; and

That this State has qualified to receive Federal assistance for the above-mentioned Public Assistance programs and has not been notified that further payment of such Federal assistance will not be made because of failure of this State to comply with the requirements of the Federal legislation; and

That Federal assistance to this State for the above-mentioned Public Assistance programs for the month of July, 1963 has not been received, and it is improbable that such Federal assistance will be received by this State prior to the usual time for transmitting such Federal assistance to the counties of this State.

In consideration of the above findings, I do hereby proclaim the existence of a period of welfare emergency and declare that the sum estimated by the State Department of Social Welfare in the amount of Federal assistance payable to this State under Federal law for the month of July, 1963 and appropriated by Section 145.3 of the Welfare and Institutions Code are available for expenditure.

You are, therefore, authorized and directed to do all things necessary to accomplish the intent and purpose of said Chapter 1.5 of Division 1 of the Welfare and Institutions Code.

Dear Governor Brown:

I have been informed by the Federal Department of Health, Education and Welfare that it is not probable federal funds to finance payments of Old Age Security, Aid to Needy Blind, Aid to Needy Children, and Aid to Needy Disabled for the month of July, 1963 will reach this State before July 1.

In order that the county treasuries may contain sufficient funds to issue warrants to recipients at the time required by statute, it is necessary for the State Controller to remit state and federal funds no later than June 27. Sections 145 et seq. of the welfare and Institutions Code authorize a loan from the General Fund whenever you proclaim the existence of a period of welfare emergency. Upon the issuance of your proclamation the State Controller will transfer the necessary funds from the General Fund to the Social Welfare Federal Fund and will issue his warrants to the counties against the latter fund.


The funds to be loaned pursuant to your proclamation amount to the following:

Old Age Security	\$11,191,718.70
Aid to Needy Blind	480,569.46
Aid to Needy Children	6,498,899.09
Aid to Needy Disabled	<u>1,492,413.28</u>
Total	\$19,663,600.53

These funds represent the federal share of anticipated aid payments for approximately 261,600 needy aged, 12,100 needy blind, 254,000 needy children and 33,200 disabled persons. Immediately upon receipt of federal funds the loan will be repaid to the General Fund.

Your execution of the attached proclamation is respectfully requested.
