SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

I, EDMUND G. BROWN, Governor of California, do hereby proclaim and order that a special election shall be held on the 23rd day of January, 1962, within the Thirtieth Assembly District of the State, (as described by Chapter 397 of the Statutes of 1951), consisting of the County of Stanislaus, to fill the vacancy in the office of State Assemblyman from said District resulting from the resignation of Assemblyman Ralph M. Brown.

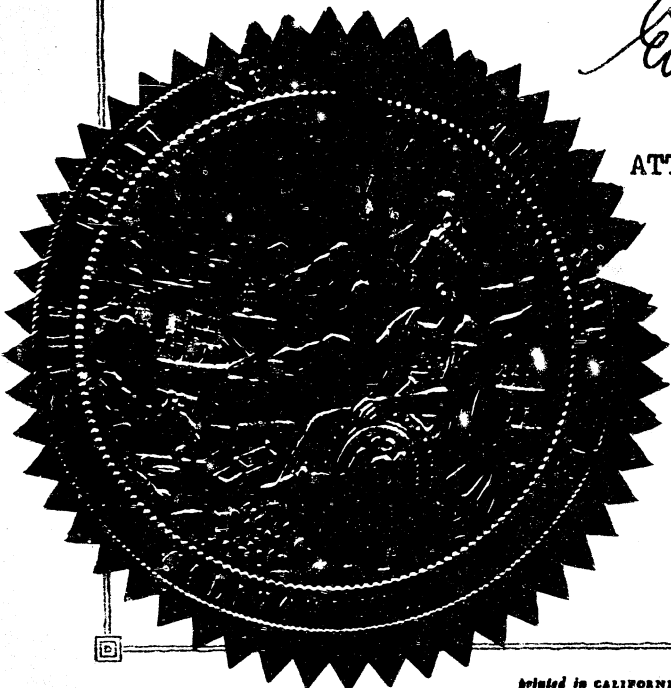
AND I DO HEREBY offer a reward of one hundred dollars for the arrest and conviction of any person who violates any of the provisions of Division 15 of the Elections Code; the rewards to be paid until the total amount hereafter expended for the purpose reaches the sum of ten thousand dollars. (\$10,000).
