PROCLAMATION  
OF  
STATE OF EMERGENCY

I, EDMUND G. BROWN JR., Governor of the State of California, find conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property are likely to exist within the State of California as a result of a potential sudden and serious gasoline shortage which may be caused by the decision announced yesterday by the President of the United States to cease oil imports from Iran. I do hereby proclaim a State of Emergency to exist in all the following counties effective 0001 hours, Monday, November 19, 1979:

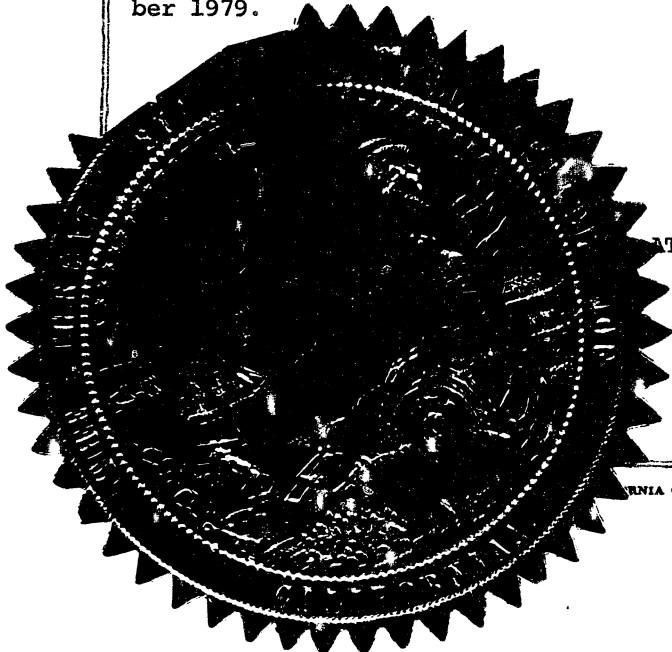

and that portion of San Bernardino County described in my proclamation of May 8, 1979, as follows: lying southerly and westerly of a line beginning at the intersection of the boundary line between San Bernardino and Los Angeles Counties and the north line of Township 3 North, Range 7 West, SBB & M, thence east along the township line to the northeast corner of Section 3, Township 3 North, Range 6 West, thence southerly and easterly following the boundary line between San Bernardino and Riverside Counties.

I hereby incorporate by reference the regulations pertaining to the California gasoline emergency to be filed with the Secretary of State not later than 5 p.m. Wednesday, November 14, 1979.

Furthermore, I direct the aforementioned program shall begin in the remainder of San Bernardino County and in all remaining counties within the State of California at 0001 hours, December 3, 1979.
